A broad, hefty style, boasting lush mocha and warm espresso aromas that lead the way for mulled plum, linzer torte and blackberry pâte de fruit flavors. The silky structure lets an iron note glide in on the finish for balance and extra length. Drink now through 2017.—J.M.

A juicy, brambly style, displaying mouthfilling cherry skin, crushed plum, blackberry and anise notes laced with light toasty spice hints and supported by mouthwatering, briary structure. Drink now through 2016.—J.M.
